Supporting persons with disabilities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Educate and facilitate integration of children/adults with mental and physical disabilities into the society ○ Training of caregivers /family members supporting persons with disabilities ○ Support employment of disabled persons

Dealing with health problems</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Projects on awareness, prevention, testing and treatment of communicable & non-communicable diseases ○ Support to persons suffering from communicable & non-communicable diseases ○ Support to people suffering from mental disorders
