

SPECIAL CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Expanding Access to Early Childhood Care at the Community Level

The National CSR Foundation invited proposals from qualifying NGOs through a Special Call for Proposals under the theme "Expanding Access to Early Childhood Care at the Community Level" with the following objectives:

- To enhance access of children from low income families to early childhood care at the community level as a means of tackling child poverty
- To support the improvement of quality and outcomes of early childhood care services provided by NGOs at the community level
- To promote holistic and innovative pedagogical approaches to early childhood care.

At the closing date of 10 May 2019, the Foundation received applications for funding from 19 NGOs.

Following the assessment exercise, Council has approved funding to 5 NGOs, as at end of August 2019, for a total amount of Rs8.36 million.
