DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:	 Teach Science and Mathematics, Languages, History & Geography to grades 5 & 6 pupils. diagnosed with learning difficulties through a pull-out system. Support the socio-emotional development of pupils. Apply lesson-based toolkit with the appropriate methods and strategies devised by the MIE. Provide a wide range of assistance to pupils who experience learning difficulties. Provide a variety of tutorials and one-to-one sessions. Liaise with the FLE Primary Coordinator to organise the pull out of pupils.

- 8. Produce worksheets and resources for the pupil in consultation with the FLE Primary Coordinator.
- Check the work pupils produce and help them to correct mistakes.

- 12. Report to the Coordinator any case of pupils being in psychological distress while respecting professional secrecy.
- 13. Engage in continuous professional development.
- 14. Assist in other FLE Programme activities as may be necessary.
- 15. Provide online learning support to learners as may be required.
- 16. Assist and participate in the preparation & organization of extracurricular activities especially during school holidays for the development of learners.
